

Dr Al-Sharekh is the director of Ibtkar Strategic Consultancy, and an associate fellow at the Chatham House's Middle East and North Africa Programme, and the Arab Gulf States Institute in Washington, DC. She has held senior consultative and teaching positions in academic, governmental and non-governmental institutions in the Arabian Gulf and abroad.

Dr Al-Sharekh holds a BA from King's College, London, and a masters and PhD from SOAS University of London. Other teaching posts Dr Alsharekh has held include full time posts at Kuwait University, Gulf University of Science and Technology, the Arab Open University, and visiting lecturer positions at Uppsala University, Sweden, and Fulbright Scholar on Women and Islam at Whittier College, USA.
