



Mr Tommy Steiner is an associate fellow at the Henry Jackson Society and a policy consultant for Signal, an Israeli policy organisation focusing on China and China–Israel relations. Concurrently, he is an adjunct lecturer and teaches international relations and security studies at the Lauder School of Government, IDC Herzliya, Israel.

Until recently, Mr Steiner was a senior research fellow at IDC Herzliya’s Institute for Policy and Strategy. He served as the executive director of the Atlantic Forum of Israel, a network-based policy organisation that promoted and advanced Israel's relations with the transatlantic community and Europe.

Mr Steiner's fields of expertise include, global politics and international security, transatlantic relations, US and EU/Nato policy in the Middle East, and Israel’s foreign relations, on which he advises Israeli authorities, international organisations, business, media and think tanks.

He earned his MA (cum laude) in international relations from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and is the recipient of the Yehoshafat Harkaby Award from the Hebrew University's Leonard Davis Institute for International Relations
