As a researcher, writer and motivational speaker, Dr Sharifa Al Yahyai is an academic expert in gender equality in Oman and the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC). She played a significant role in improving women's rights-related national polices in Oman when she was Minister of Social Development from 2004 to 2011.

During her time as minister, Dr Al Yahyai contributed significantly towards 17 October being designated as Omani Women's Day by His Majesty, the Sultan of Oman, then.

Since her appointment as Minister of Social Development in 2004, she has been participating actively in several national and international conventions related to women's empowerment, children's rights, civil society and the overall social development in Oman. In 2005, Dr Al Yahyai was awarded the Civil Ordinance of Oman- Class II by HM The Sultan Qaboos and in 2008, she received the Arab Woman Distinguished Award from Arab Women Foundation in social work. In addition to these accolades, in 2018, Dr Al Yahyai received the Arab Women Award of the Year by London Arabia Foundation and Regent London University.
