British PM Starmer to Visit Saudi Arabia, UAE

#### British Prime Minister Keir Starmer is set to visit Riyadh and Abu Dhabi next month, with plans to strengthen ties with the wealthy Gulf states. Sources indicate that London aims to attract investments, including energy projects from the

Qatar Emir To Pay State Visit To London Qatar's Emir, Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani, will make a state visit to the United Kingdom in December, Buckingham Palace announced on Thursday. King Charles III and Queen Camilla will host the Emir and his consort, Sheikha Jawaher bint Hamad Al-Thani, during their visit on 3-4 December.
