


US Says it Could Recognise New Syrian Government

Ethiopia and Somaliland Reach Truce in Turkey-brokered Talks

An official stated that negotiations between leaders from both sides and their respective teams lasted nearly seven uninterrupted hours, with Turkish

The Biden administration has said it will recognise and support a new government in Syria if it can commit to several actions, including renouncing terrorism and destroying any chemical weapons depots in the country.

President Recep Tayyip Erdogan and his Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan actively participating. Under the deal, known as the Ankara Declaration, Somalia secured Ethiopia's recognition of its territorial unity, while Addis Ababa was granted commercial access to the Somali coastline.
